Through BEN, we are awarding ten eligible high school students like you with a \$5,000 renewable scholarship (\$20,000 total over 4 years) to make the most of their education.

Check out the eligibility requirements below:

- High school students of Black or African descent in the U.S.
- Graduating high school in 2021, or recently graduated in 2020
- Have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or its equivalent)
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident

Employees and immediate family members of Amazon.com and its subsidiaries are not eligible to apply.

Recipients receive \$5,000 a year while pursuing a bachelor's degree in computer science, supply chain, or operations. Students can renew that scholarship 4x for a total of \$20,000.
