Dear RHS families and students,

Thank you for taking the time to read this update about the graduation requirement, High School and Beyond Plan (HSBP). Career Cruising is the online tool that Renton School District utilizes to meet the graduation requirement. It can be worked on from any device that can access the internet and provides guidance in post-secondary planning. Now is the perfect time to work on it while school is on the COVID-19 closure.

The original deadline for 12th graders to have this completed by May 15, 2020 to stay on track to graduate is still currently in effect. Seniors may complete it before then, and that is strongly recommended. This will take several hours and should not be put off.

9th graders will be completing this in their High School Success class. If you are scheduled for High School Success class in Tri 3, please go to the instructions for 9th grade HSBP and get this completed by June 1st. Once you complete 9th grade requirement, you can go on to the 10th grade instructions and get a head start.

All 10th and 11th graders have been working on this in their Advisory classes this year and are also advised to log on and complete the requirements per the directions for their grade level. It is recommended that you then continue on and get a head start on the next grade level. Many of the different activities will be focused on next year in school but it makes sense to work on these now while you have extra time.

Community service can be completed at any time before your 12th grade year and we recommend you get this done as soon as you can, once WA State Gov. Inslee has lifted the temporary stay at home order. Please do not wait until Senior year as it is a very busy time and it goes very quickly!
